7:00 a.m. & 7:00 p.m.




This breakfast will provide an opportunity to renew meaningful relationships with our members and build new ones with our guests. We hope to see you there!

The following are some of the highlighted ministry items the board discussed:

- > No real updates on pastoral search except it is being worked on.
- > ROSC #2 is going well. ROSC #3 is scheduled for January 23 - February 27.
- > Pathfinders approved for additional \$5,000 to purchase tents, etc., for camping trips.
- > Pray for the Youth within our church family. Volunteer teachers needed for Youth Sabbath School.
- > Four additional individuals want to transfer into our church family.
- > Lighting repairs in the sanctuary have been made and new lights in the foyer have been installed.

- > Nominating Committee 2023 will be selected on Sabbath, October 7. Seven members with a minimum of five at each meeting. No more than one individual from each family and no more than two related members.
- > Week of Prayer scheduled for October 1 - 7 for all church Nominating Committee.
